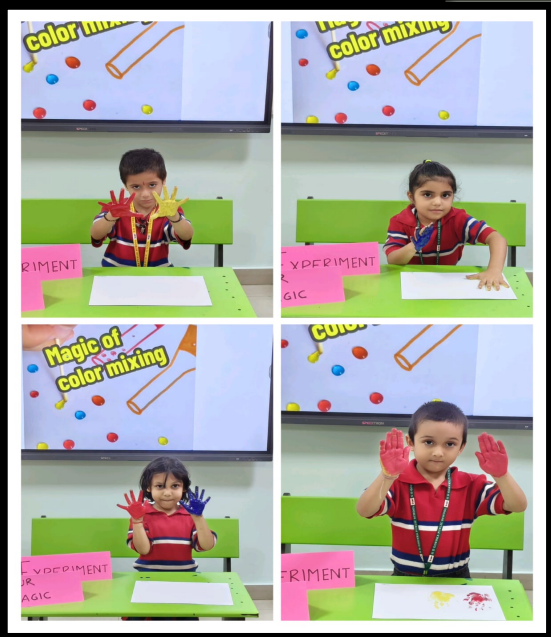
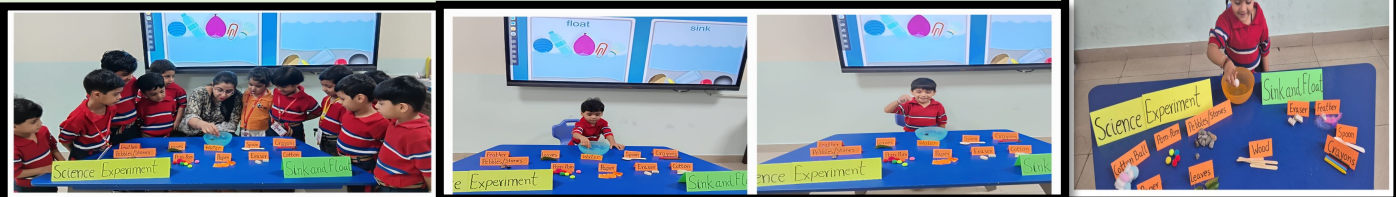


Time to Experiment

Time to Experiment

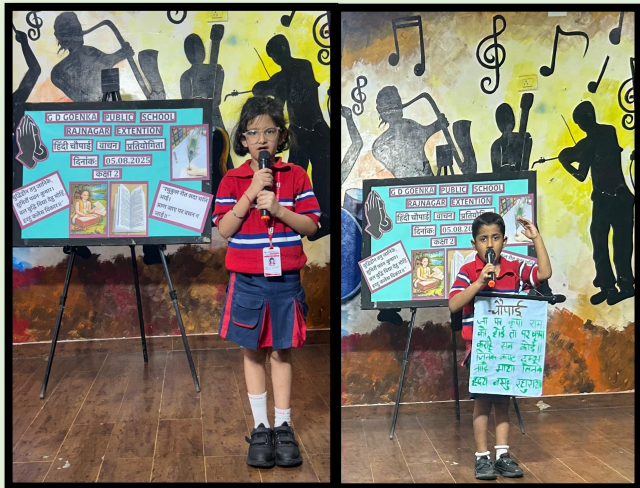
-Grade LKG and UKG

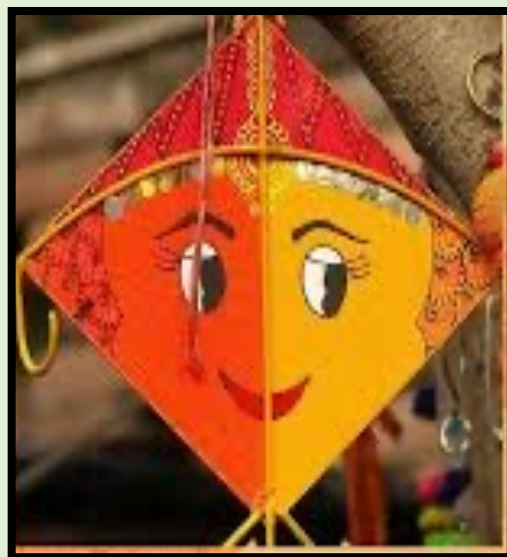
COMPETITIONS AND ACTIVITIES

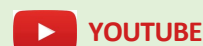
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
