Science Experiment (Blooming Flowers)

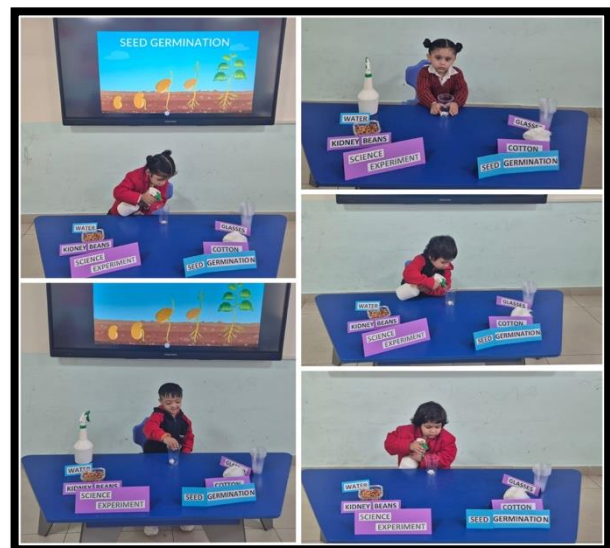

Science Experiment (Seed Germination)

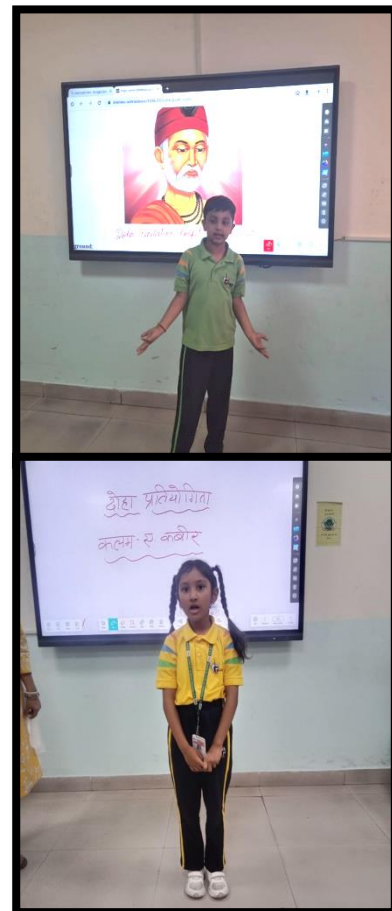
Intra House Doha Recitation Competition

The sincere efforts, teamwork, and confidence of the students were praiseworthy. The message that echoed through the assembly was — “We rise by lifting others.”

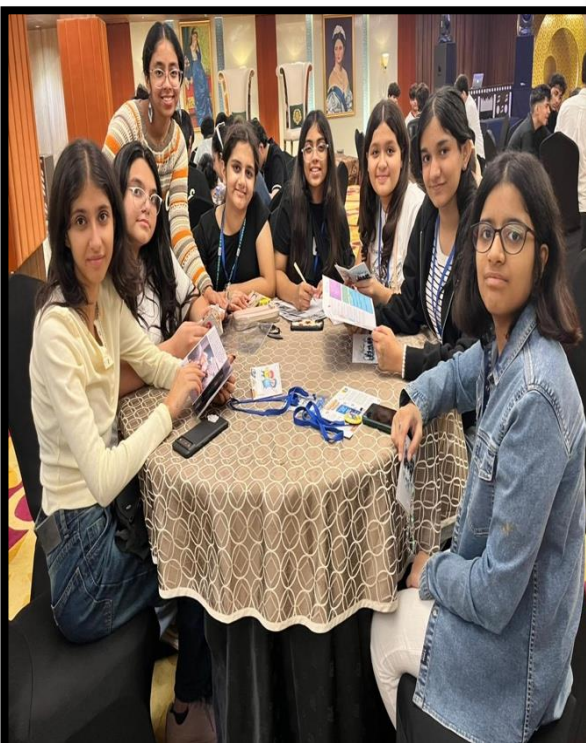


EXCURSION

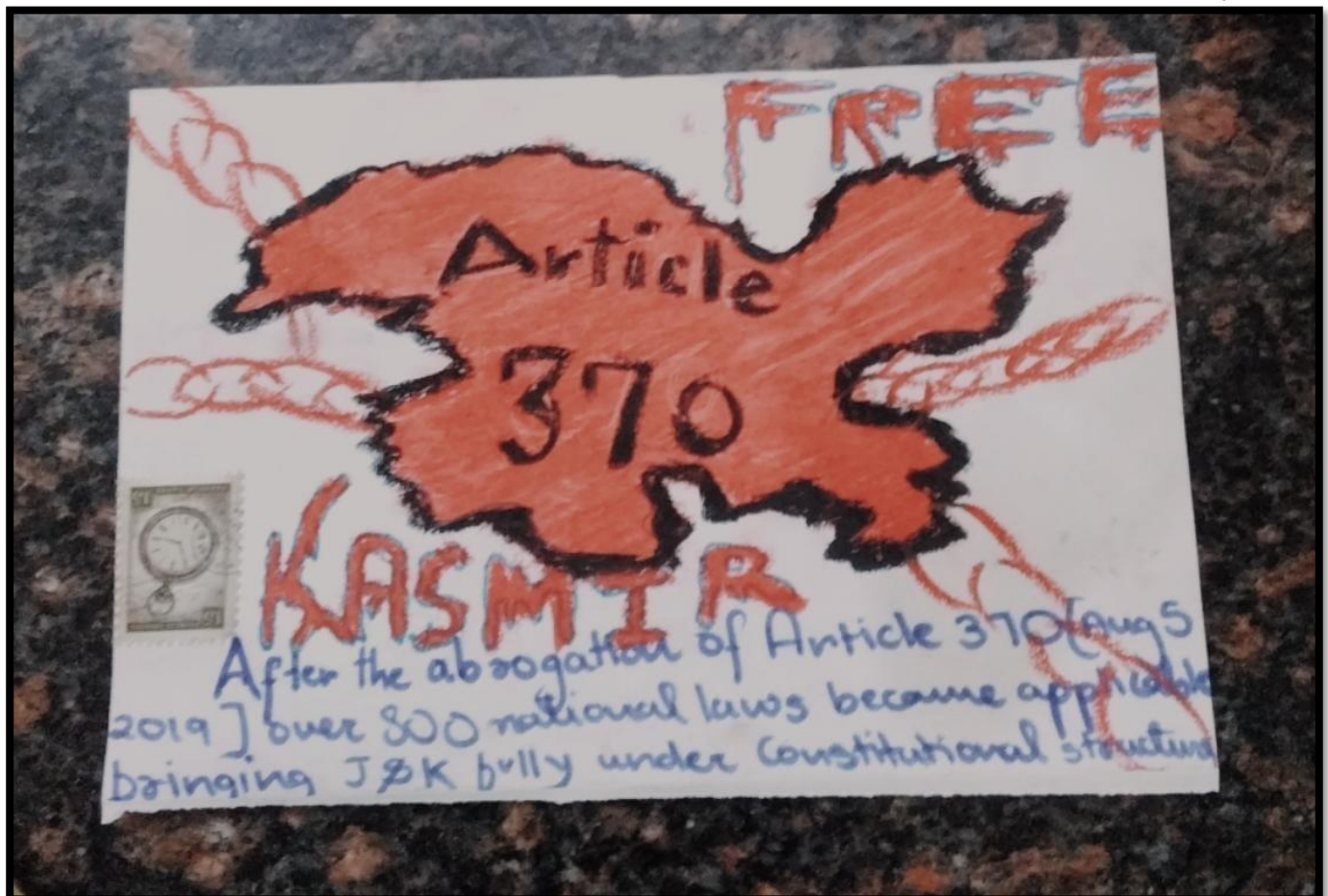
